

Town Hall Reopening:

Town Hall will reopen to the public on July 1<sup>st</sup> with the following precautions.

- We would prefer that masks be worn.
- We will not approach the counter unless needed. If you are making a payment by check, please place in the box provided at the counter payment window.
- **Credit Card Payments will no longer be taken over the phone.**
- We would prefer that cash not be used unless absolutely necessary.
- If the sneeze guard is installed please stay in that area.
- Try to maintain a distance if another customer is in the lobby area although we know that may not be possible. Stay outside if necessary.



Fireworks:

Town Ordinance 2020-4, Revised Fire Works Ordinance, establishes the following schedule for permitted use of fireworks:

- June 29, 30 and July 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 - between 5:00 PM and 11:00 PM.
- July 4 - 10:00 am until Midnight.

Penalties will be assessed under Town Code and are as follows:

First Offense	\$25.00
Second Offense	\$50.00
Third Offense	\$100.00
All offenses after	\$200.00

Each offense is considered a separate and additional offense even if in the same day.

Please call County Dispatch at 260-356-8316 for officer assistance if you need to report use of fireworks outside of the listed times.



INDOT Paving Project:

Scheduled to start on August 3<sup>rd</sup>, a major construction project which will impact the Town of Warren and Warren area is as follows:

- SR 5 From just North of Dollar General south to the bridge.
- SR 218 From the traffic light east to SR 3.

The patching preparation was to have been completed the week of June 29<sup>th</sup>. The project includes milling and paving so will result in interruption of traffic. Please try to avoid these areas if possible. Signs will be posted as the work proceeds.
