Meetings called as Special Sessions are Council Meetings open to the public which are scheduled for a day or time different from the regular schedule.

### PROJECTS UPDATE



On February 27th, signage has been added on Second Street indicating road closure on or after March 4<sup>th</sup>. The project was originally scheduled to start on April 1<sup>st</sup> but, due to a mild winter, it is underway now. It is not expected that the street will be completely closed for some time, but there may be traffic delays and certain sections of the street may be closed for work at any time. ### ECLIPSE



Happening in Warren, and many other locations in the State and country on April 8<sup>th</sup>, will be a total eclipse with Warren and Markle included in the area to be in total darkness. Preparations are underway by the Festival Committee to have a one day event with food vendors and other activities. Second Street from Wayne to Nancy will be closed for the event, street lights will be adjusted to stop automatic activation, extra officers will be available and more. There is no way to know the impact it will have here as to how many people from out of town may arrive. Through the month of March, more information will become available through facebook sites such as the Town of Warren, Huntington County Homeland Security, Huntington County Tourism and Indiana State Police as well as other sites offering tips on how to view the eclipse.
