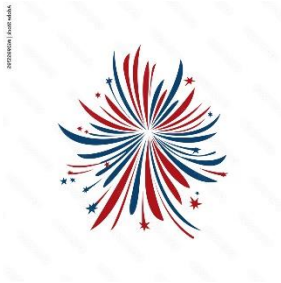


June 1, 2026



Salamonie Summer Festival:

Water Hydrant Flushing:

Hydrants will be flushed throughout the month of June. When hydrant is open, there could be a drop in pressure and rusty water may be seen. Take steps before doing laundry, etc.

2026 Fall Election:

Two Council positions will be up for election on November 3rd. To file candidacy, a petition of nomination must be filed at the Court House Voter Registration Office by noon on June 30, 2026. At least six signatures from registered voters within the Town are needed to file the petition form along with a candidacy form. Recommended is to fill the ten spaces for assurance that enough valid signatures are on the form. Forms are available at Town Hall, at the Indiana Election Site, and at the Election Office. Ph: 260-358-4820. The term will be four years. You must be a registered voter in the Salamonie 2 Precinct (Town of Warren).
